A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Title 10, Chapter 6 by adding a new Section 10.602 and a new Section 10.603 to regulate the process of appointment of the Kosrae State representative to the Compact Management Board of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and to require prompt reporting or Board activities to the Executive and Legislature; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Purpose. To amend Title 10, Chapter 6 by adding a new
2 Section 10.602 to regulate the process of appointment of the Kosrae State representative
3 to the Compact Management Board of the National Government of the Federated States
4 of Micronesia.

5 Section 2. Amendment. Title 10, Chapter 6 is hereby amended by adding a
6 new Section 10.602 to read as follows:

7 “Section 10.602 Compact Management Board, The National
8 Government of the FSM has, pursuant to Title 55 Chapter 15 of the FSM Code, created
9 the Compact Management Board. The State of Kosrae is entitled to appoint one member
10 to this Board.

11 (1) Giving consideration to the knowledge of finance, accounting and
12 economic principles and written and verbal communication skills of a
13 nominee, the Governor shall nominate one member to the Board to serve
14 at the Governor’s pleasure for a period of no less than one year.

15 (2) Any nomination to the Compact Management Board shall require the
16 consent by resolution of the Kosrae State Legislature.

17 (3) The Governor may terminate the appointment of the Board member at any
18 time after the initial one year period, with or without cause.”

19 Section 3. Amendment. Title 10, Chapter 6 is hereby amended by adding a
20 new Section 10.603 to read as follows:

1 “Section 10.603 Reporting of Compact Activities. The Kosraean
2 member of the Compact Management Board is required to provide a report to the
3 Executive and Legislative Branches of the State Government, no more than five
4 (5) working days after the conclusion of a Board meeting. The report shall detail
5 the substance of discussions at the meeting as well as provide copies of
6 documents presented to the Board and any resolutions adopted by the Board.

7 Section 4. Effective Date. This Act takes effect upon approval by the
8 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
